### **Georgia Litigation update**

- Judge Steve Jones ruling February 28
  - Plaintiffs are substantially likely to establish VRA Section 2 violations
  - Denies request for preliminary injunction too close to the election
  - Cases will proceed on similar schedule to 3-judge panel cases
  - Possible net change: +1 Congressional, +2 Senate, +3 House districts for Black majorities
- Observations
  - The Kemp Gambit worked signing delayed to December 30
  - History: February 23, 2012 new maps enacted w. no impact to election
  - Risk of adverse ruling by Supreme Court in Alabama case
