First-ever redistricting survey of Georgia voters

- National firm based in NC, experienced with redistricting polling
- Methodology: IVR to land lines (40%), text to cell lines (60%)
- Field work completed July 28-29
- 524 responses from registered voters statewide, weighted to state demographics, margin of error +/-4.3%
- 18 questions (9 content, 9 demographics)
- Results cross-tabbed with standard demographic questions (party, race, sex, age, education level, 2020 presidential vote), urban/suburban/rural and poll mode













Whom did we survey?




Most voters (57%) aware of redistricting; Democrats most engaged




Overall, voters have low confidence in fairness of maps, but differ greatly based on party affiliation.

> From what you know, do you think the maps legislators drew were mostly fair or mostly unfair?





Overall, voters express low satisfaction with redistricting; Democrats much less satisfied than others.

Voters overwhelmingly want competitive districts, but Georgia does not have them.















Overall, voters want map to reflect racial diversity; Republicans less enthusiastic than others.

Clear majority of voters from across Georgia want cohesive representation for their communities.



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Across the board, voters support changing the law to require non-partisan redistricting.












Support for an independent redistricting commission outweighs opposition across the political spectrum.
